## **INFOGRAPHIC PUBLICATION**

An infographic (information graphic) is a representation of information in a graphic format designed to make the data easily understandable at a glance.

People use infographics to quickly communicate a message, to simplify the presentation of large amounts of data.



## Example of a publication

STEP 1: Identify the keywords/numbers.

A total of 9010 evacuees were evacuated, with 6,348 individuals (1,712 households) registered in Santo as of 8 September and 2,662 individuals (780 households) registered on Maewo as of 28 August 2018.

A total 1,253 children (639 boys, 614 girls) make up 47 per cent of the evacuees on Maewo of which 17 per cent are under the age of 5 years (459 children). (NDMO report 2018).

**STEP 2:** *Highlight the keywords/numbers.*

Brief

The volcano alert level for Manaro Voui Volcano on Ambae Island in Vanuatu decreased in late September to level 2 by the Vanuatu Meteorology and Geo-Hazards Department (VMGD).

The risk of the Ambae volcano escalate to a level of minor eruption is now considered low. A state of emergency was extended until 26 November 2018, during which food supplies and essential services were continually provided by the Government and NGO's to displaced communities on both Maewo and Santo Islands.

A total evacuation of Ambae was completed with most residents relocating to nearby islands. Maewo Island was the designated relocation site for evacuees by the Government, although a greater number of Ambaens relocated to Santo on their own cost.

## Activity

There are several NGO's that are willing to commit resources to assist in the evacuation process like the Adventist Development and Relief Agency (ADRA) which plans to to distribute 260 Hygiene and 257 Dignity kits and to meet the immediate protection needs of 700 women, boys and girls.

## Activity

The Adventist Development and Relief Agency (ADRA) is planning to Enable 4,135 children, women and men of West Ambae to be repatriated after evacuation due to volcano eruption threat.

Furthermore, immediate response and recovery support worth \$142,426 will be provided in the form of WASH and protection of water sources, village action initiatives, and evacuation center kits aligning with NDMO requirements.
